

Product Bulletin: Upgrading to MGOS 4.2 or Later

MG90s performing firmware upgrade via the AMM requires installation of intermediate transition firmware.

Applicable Products

MG90 routers that are upgrading to MGOS 4.2 or later firmware via the AMM.

Exempt products:

MG90s upgrading via USB stick install are not affected. MG90s upgrading from MG0S 4.2.1 or later firmware are also not affected.

Summary

MG90 routers upgrading from MGOS 4.2.0 or earlier firmware via the AMM, need to first install transition firmware before upgrading to the latest. Failure to install the transition firmware prior to upgrading to the latest firmware will result in upgrade failures and can require a USB-stick install to recover.

The required transition firmware will depend on the current operating firmware version.

b) MG90s operating with MGOS 4.0.x firmware version

All MG90s upgrading from MGOS 4.0.x via the AMM must first upgrade to MGOS 4.1, and then

install the transition firmware before upgrading to the latest.

Important: Ensure the AMM is upgraded to AMM 2.16 or newer before performing the MGOS firmware upgrades. Upgrading using older AMM versions will result in MGOS firmware upgrade failures, and can require a USB-stick install to recover. Recommended Steps

Sierra Wireless advises customers with affected units wishing to perform an AMM-based firmware

upgrade to follow the steps below or contact Sierra Wireless Support for assistance.

- 1. Confirm that the AMM has been updated to version 2.16 or later.
- 2. Identify the appropriate transition firmware required, based on the current MGOS firmware version on the router.

Current MGOS Firmware	Required Transition Firmware
MGOS 4.2.0	MGOS 4.2.0.2
MGOS 4.1, 4.1.2	MGOS 4.1.2.2
MGOS 4.0.3, 4.0.4, 4.0.5	MGOS 4.1 + MGOS 4.1.2.2

- 3. Upgrade to the required transition firmware.
- 4. Promptly upgrade to the latest firmware.
